

PDC 2022 Summer Conference Health and Safety Statement

The Professional Development Consortium (“PDC”) is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all 2022 PDC Summer Conference participants. Our decisions about measures to help prevent the potential spread of COVID-19 will be guided by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC), World Health Organization (WHO), and state and local health authorities in Denver, Colorado.

Preventive measures include:

- Proof of up-to-date vaccination as defined by the CDC: Up-to-date means a person has received all recommended COVID-19 vaccines, including any booster dose(s) when eligible.¹ Please see the [CDC's website](#) for further detail on up-to-date vaccination status.
- Enhanced sanitization of meeting and exhibit spaces.
- Hand sanitizing stations throughout the hotel and offsite event locations.
- Any other preventive measures deemed necessary by the Board of Directors at the time of the program, including but not limited to masking and social distancing.

The responsibility for a safe and healthy event environment is shared among the event organizer, venues, and every participant. In addition to the requirements above, all 2022 PDC Summer Conference participants are expected to adhere to the PDC’s safety precautions. To that end, you agree that you will not attend the 2022 Summer PDC Conference if you:

- are experiencing, or within the 10 days prior to the program have experienced [signs or symptoms of COVID-19](#);
- believe that you may have been exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 within 10 days prior to the event; or
- have been diagnosed with COVID-19 or tested positive for COVID-19 within 5 days of the start of the conference, even if you are not experiencing any symptoms.

Any attendee who tests positive for COVID-19 during the conference will be asked to leave immediately. We ask any conference attendee who experiences symptoms of COVID-19 within 10 days of the close of the 2022 PDC Summer Conference to contact PDC Managing Director Maria Lopez at maria.lopez@pdclegal.org.

You assume all risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that you may experience or incur in connection with attending the PDC 2022 Summer Conference. You hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the PDC, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from any such claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs, or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto.

Specifically relating to the global COVID-19 pandemic, you acknowledge the highly contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk of exposure or infection by attending the PDC 2022 Summer Conference, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, disability, and/or death. You understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the PDC 2022 Summer Conference may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of others who may attend the event or their families, colleagues, or others with whom you may have contact. Accordingly, you

understand and agree that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of PDC, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in the PDC 2022 Summer Conference.

In addition to all other rules and regulations relating to your attendance at the PDC 2022 Summer Conference indicated above, you agree to comply with all COVID-related procedures that may be implemented by the PDC and Four Seasons Hotel Denver, including, but not limited to, mask-wearing and social distancing requirements and restrictions on certain activities that carry higher COVID-related risk, in order to protect as much as possible the health and safety of all PDC 2022 Summer Conference attendees. You understand that refusal to adhere to these policies and abide by these precautions may result in immediate removal from the event and cancellation of the registration, without receiving a refund.

All PDC policies, including those related to health and safety precautions, are subject to change. Should changes be made, a notification will be sent to all registered attendees.
